Just a quick overview of what went on at the meeting tonight:

Finances

There should be 2 people on every troop checking account. Hold on to your monthly statements for 3 years, in June every troop will be required to fill out a SIMPLE finance form (how much you started with, income, expenses, balance, etc) This form is available online, plus I will hand them out in a few months.

Deadlines

Any paperwork that goes out for an event will have a firm deadline on it.

Town Events

If a troop opts out of a town event please notify your parents that there is this event but you will not be participating BUT if a parent would like to run it for your troop that would be fine.
