



Mountainside CAC Leaders Meeting Minutes
April 19, 2007

Thank you to all the leaders who were able to make the meeting. Here is a quick recap of what went on:

Everyone who ran an event: Hayride, Mitten tree, Badge Day, Father/Daughter, Swap night, etc was asked to put together a **folder** with contact info, their thoughts on what worked and what did not, suggestions, etc. Please hand this in at the next Leaders' meeting May 23.

Court of Awards:

May 16th 7PM Our Lady of Lourdes, Cost is \$10 per troop.
The Scout, parents, friends, etc, are encouraged to come but we will need to have an approximate head count. Scouts are asked to dress appropriately: white logo shirt, vest/sash, nice pants or whatever you as the leader deem acceptable. Kitty and Kathy need know if your troop is bridging, if you earned the bronze, silver, or gold award, community service award, five or ten year membership pin. Money and forms are due back by May 2nd. We will get the forms on the website.

Camping Oct 12-14, 2007.

A \$25 NONFUNDABLE deposit is due from every scout/adult by May 21st. We do not know the cost yet but it will be more than that. We are trying to get someone to run the kitchen for Saturday lunch and dinner so each troop is only responsible for breakfast.

From those who were there it was decided that First grade Brownies would go up on Saturday for the day, Second Grade Brownies will go up Saturday for one night and Third grade Brownies will go up for two nights

We will exchange swaps at camp, you can make them before hand or bring up your supplies and do them in the creation studio. Each troop will have a chance to visit the camp store and we will decide the maximum amount of money the girls can bring. If you have extra parents who really want to come camping with us please talk to Nancy or Mary. We would like to give them a half day job assignment (mind the creation studio, ball field, etc)

No more than 2 pieces of luggage - a small duffel or backpack and a sleeping bag. Each girl will have to carry her own stuff (a friend may help). One car per troop and it will be parked in the parking lot once unloaded. Every troop must have one leader on the bus tending to her troop.

Everyone is to think of how we want to handle quiet time violators - it will be enforced (giggles and whispers fine, running around screaming - NOT). Each troop will donate a few prizes for bingo (collected in September - start looking through the closets). Everyone is encourage to early bird register so it is done before the summer.

Jobs that still need to be filled:

First Aid person (nurse) for encampment

Organize the ice skating fund raiser over the summer - it is really just a matter of putting up flyers and collecting money - whatever we make will help lessen the amount paid for camping - it will probably be about \$45 per person, leader, or parent. (can be more than one)
